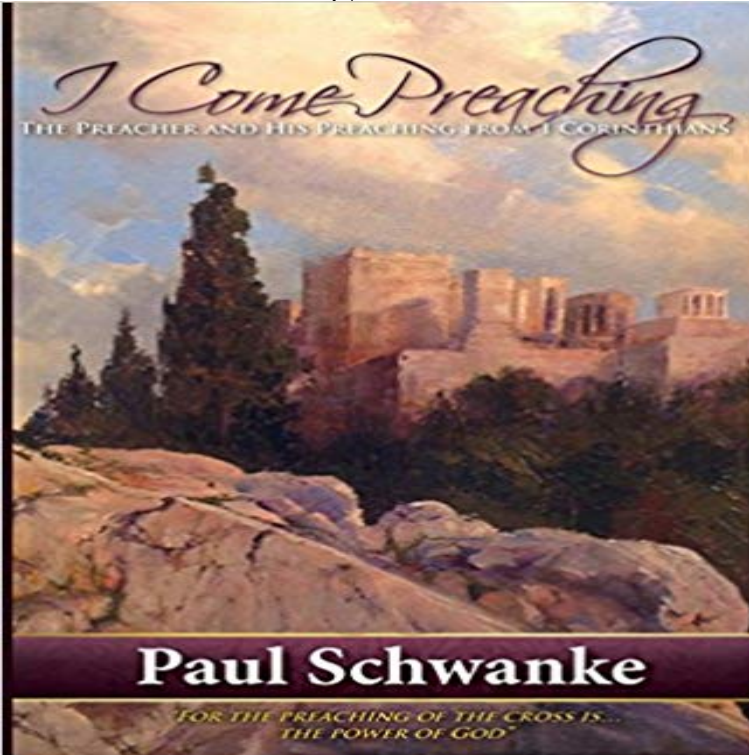


I Come Preaching: The Preacher and His Preaching from 1 Corinthians
