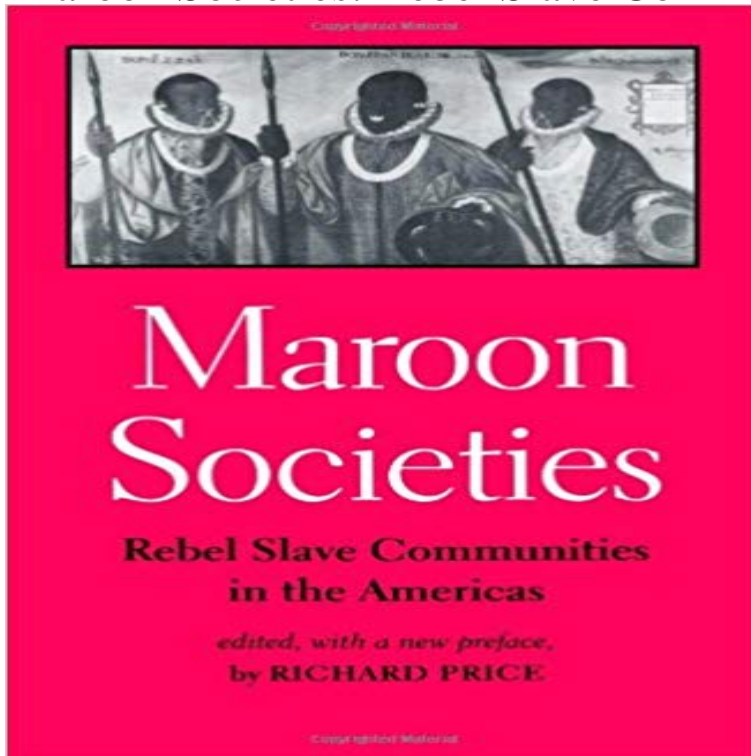


Maroon Societies: Rebel Slave Communities in the Americas
