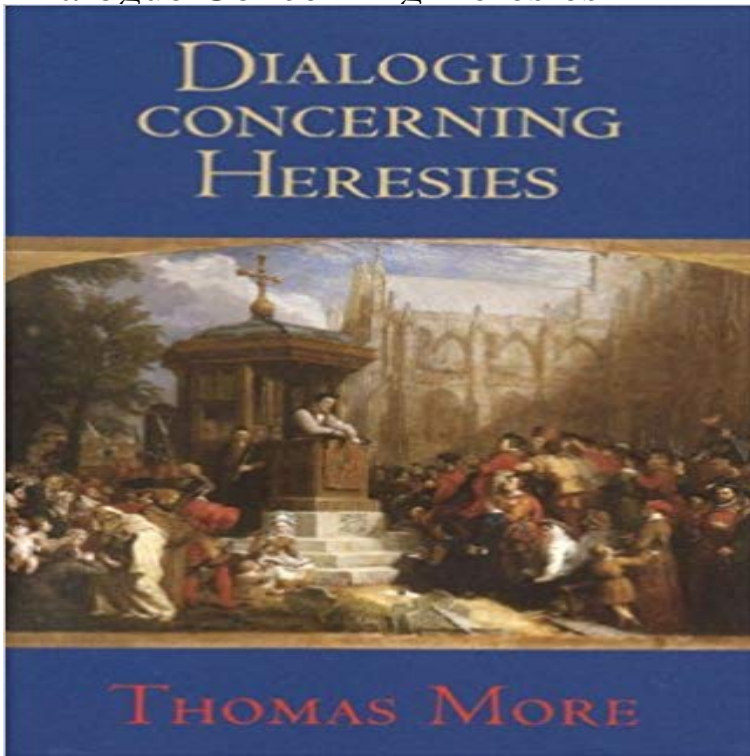


Dialogue Concerning Heresies

Dialogue Concerning Heresies is a conversation between the experienced humanist and statesman More and an intelligent college student who has been influenced by the spirit and ideas of the new men and reformers, especially Martin Luther and William Tyndale. It addresses questions that continue to be discussed today: Isnt it idolatry to pray to saints, venerate images, and go on pilgrimages? Why listen to what the Church teaches? Shouldnt we go only by Scripture, since it is the word of God? Why didnt the Church want laypeople to have their own Bible, and in English? How do we know which church is the true one? Why waste time on philosophy and other secular studies if the Bible is Gods revealed word? This modernized edition of Mores Dialogue brings this masterful work into wide circulation for the first time since its publication in 1529.
