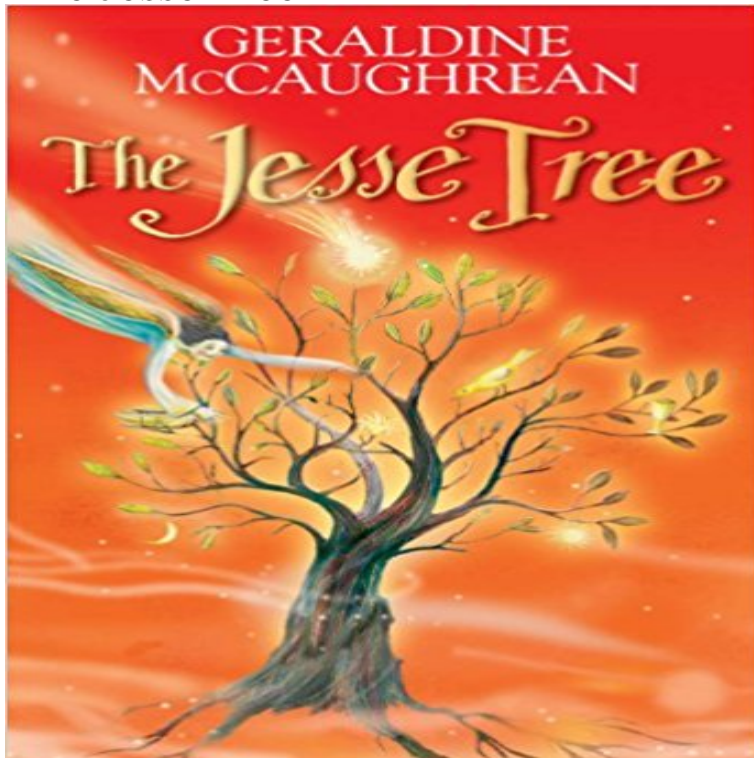


The Jesse Tree
