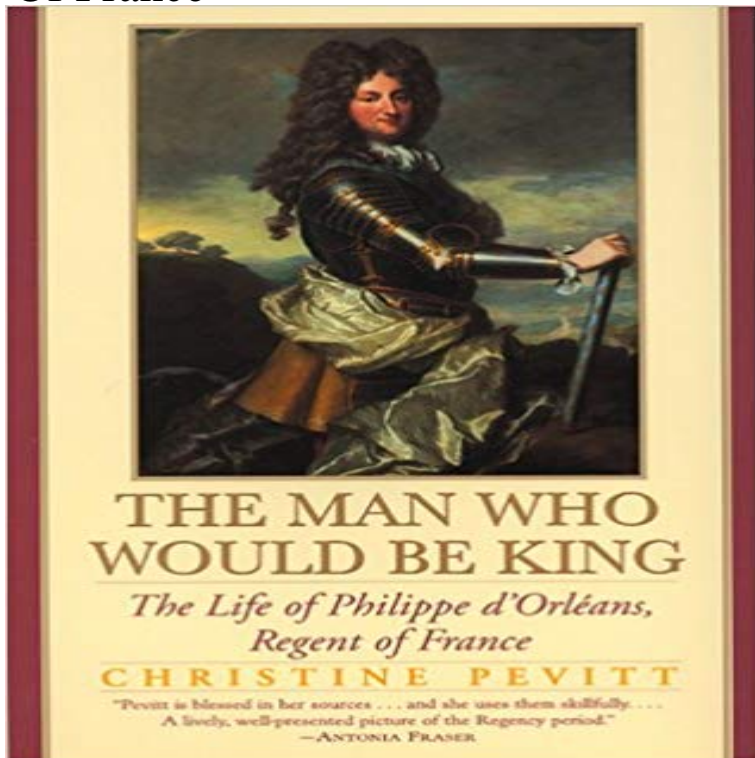


The Man Who Would Be King: The Life Of Philippe Dorleans, Regent Of France
