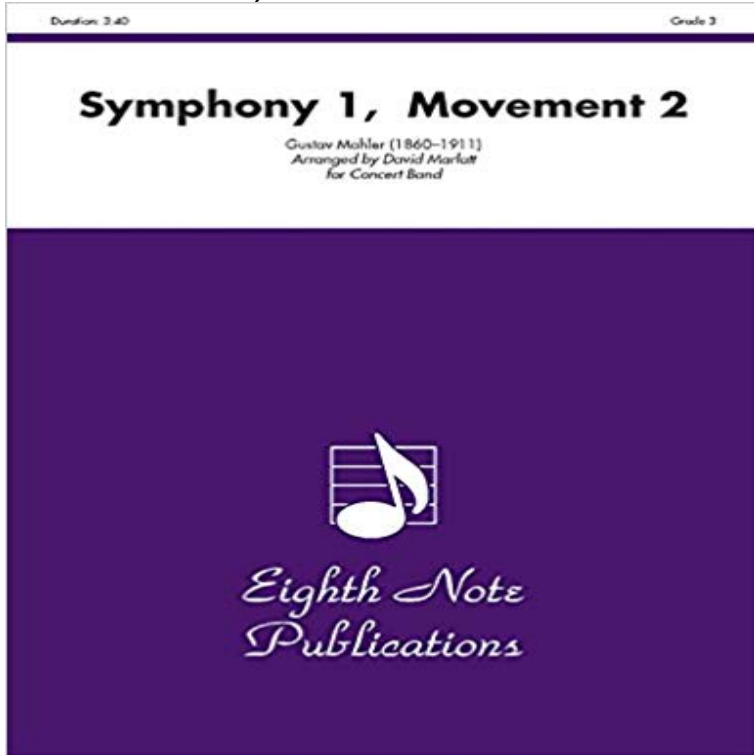


# Symphony 1 (Movement 2): Conductor Score & Parts (Eighth Note Publications)
