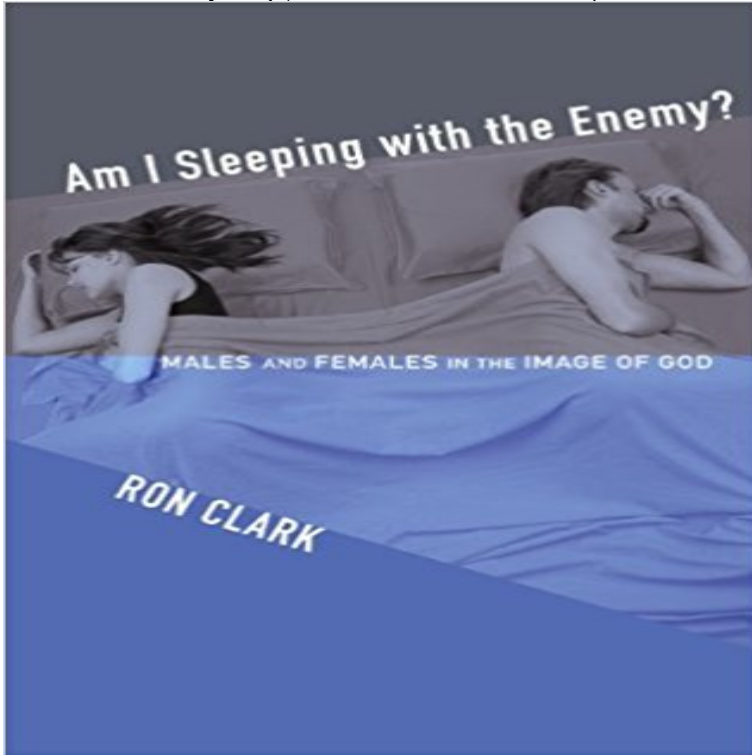


Am I Sleeping with the Enemy?: Males and Females in the Image of God
