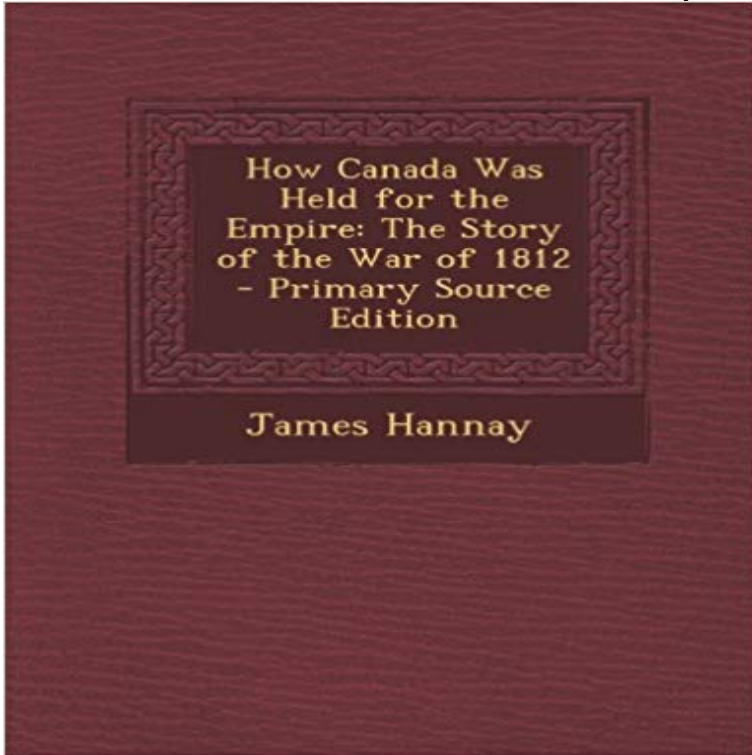


How Canada Was Held for the Empire: The Story of the War of 1812
