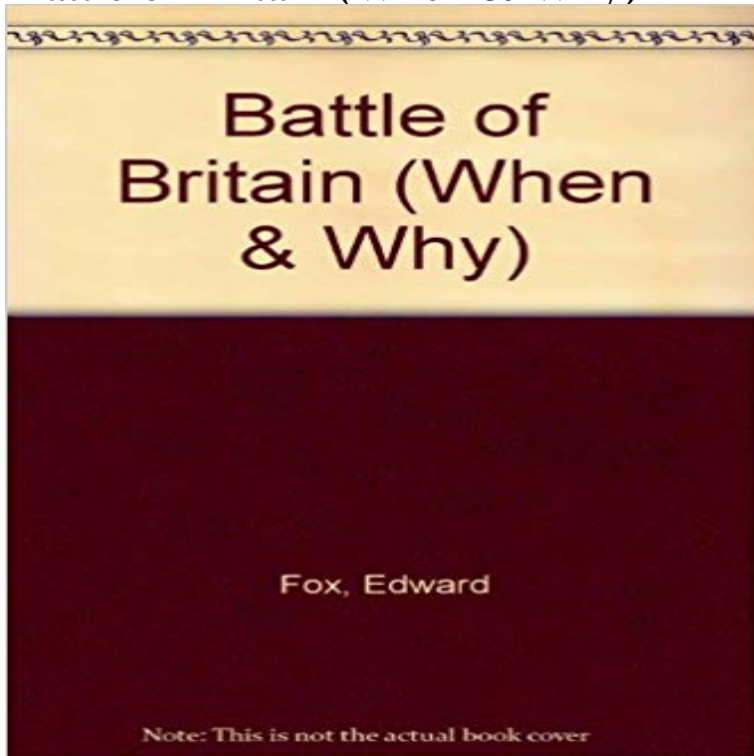


Battle of Britain (When & Why)
