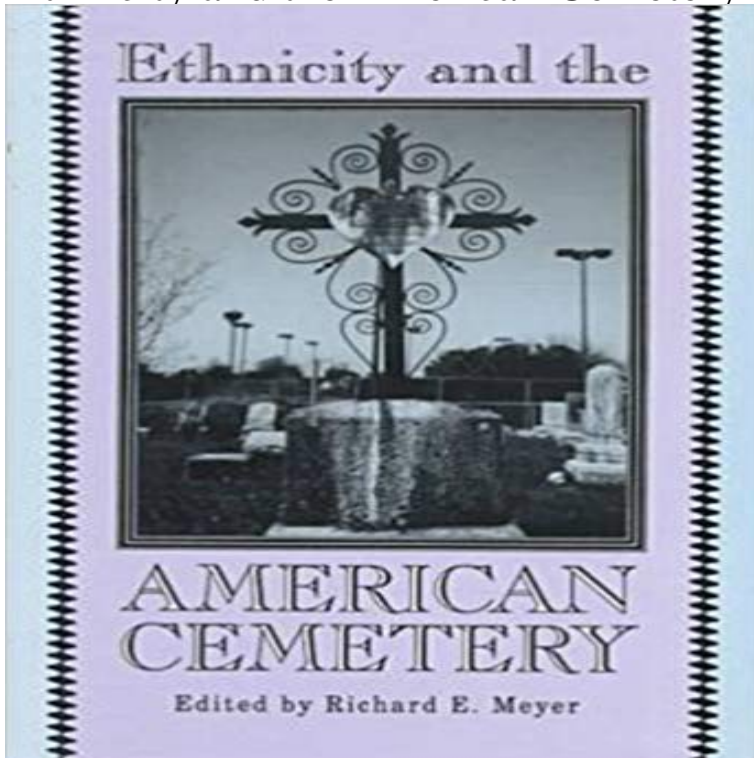


Ethnicity and the American Cemetery (Popular Music Series)
