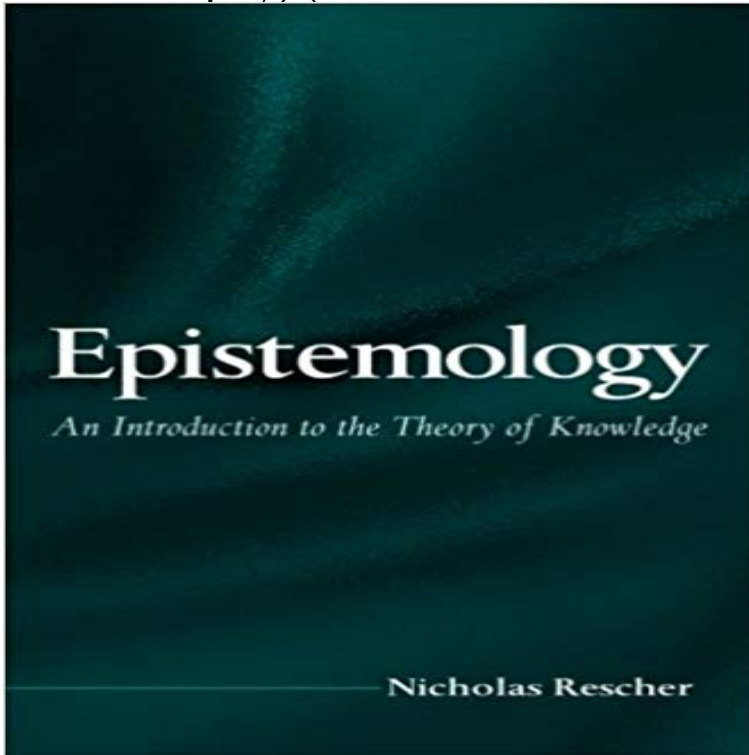


Epistemology: An Introduction to the Theory of Knowledge (Sunny Series in Philosophy) (SUNY Series in Philosophy (Paperback))
