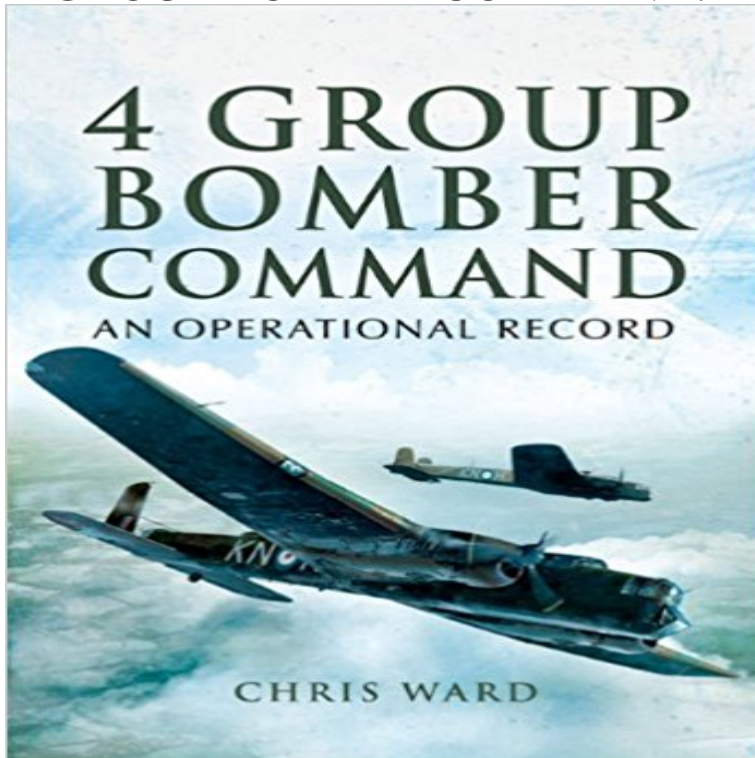


4 GROUP BOMBER COMMAND: An Operational Record
