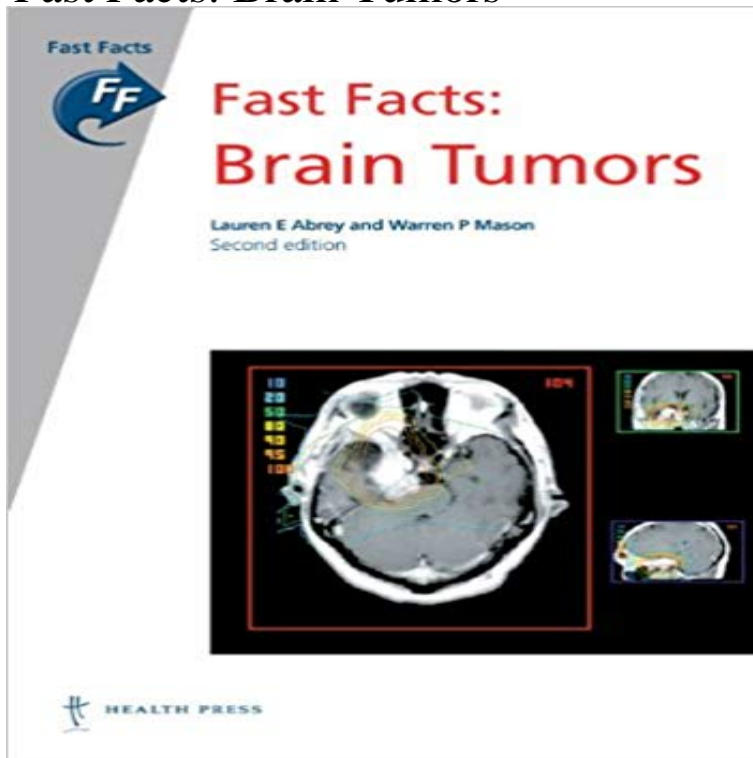


Fast Facts: Brain Tumors
