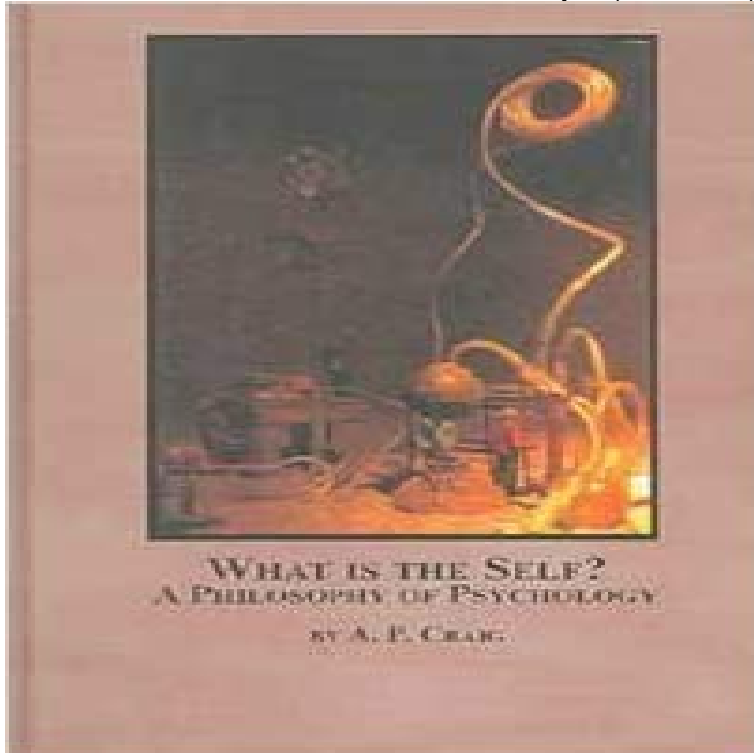


# What is the Self?: A Philosophy of Psychology
