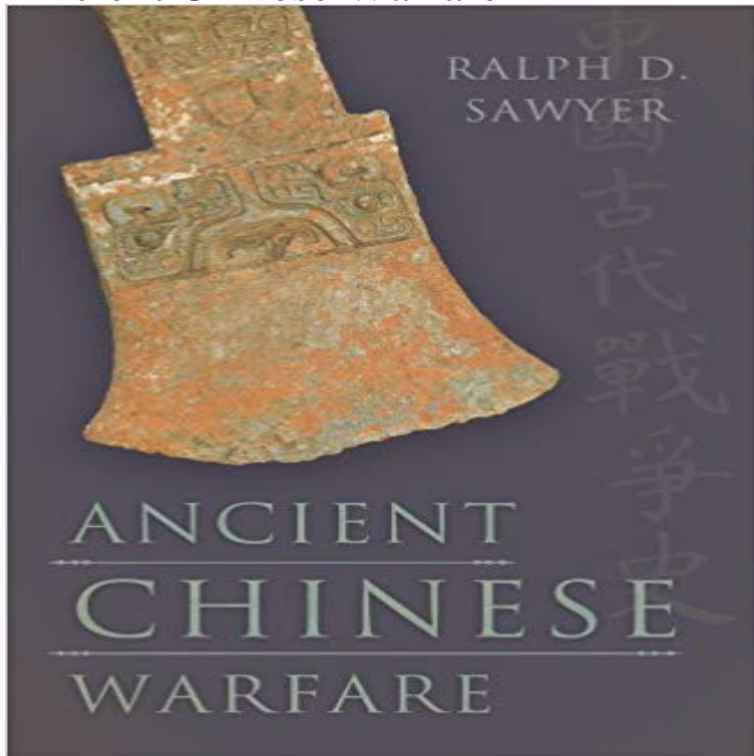


## Ancient Chinese Warfare
