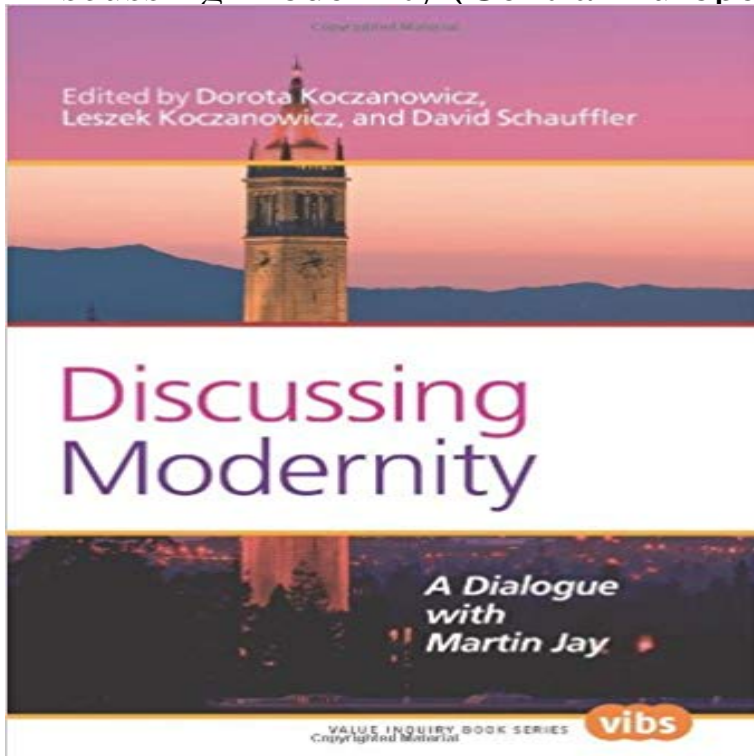


Discussing Modernity (Central European Value Studies)
