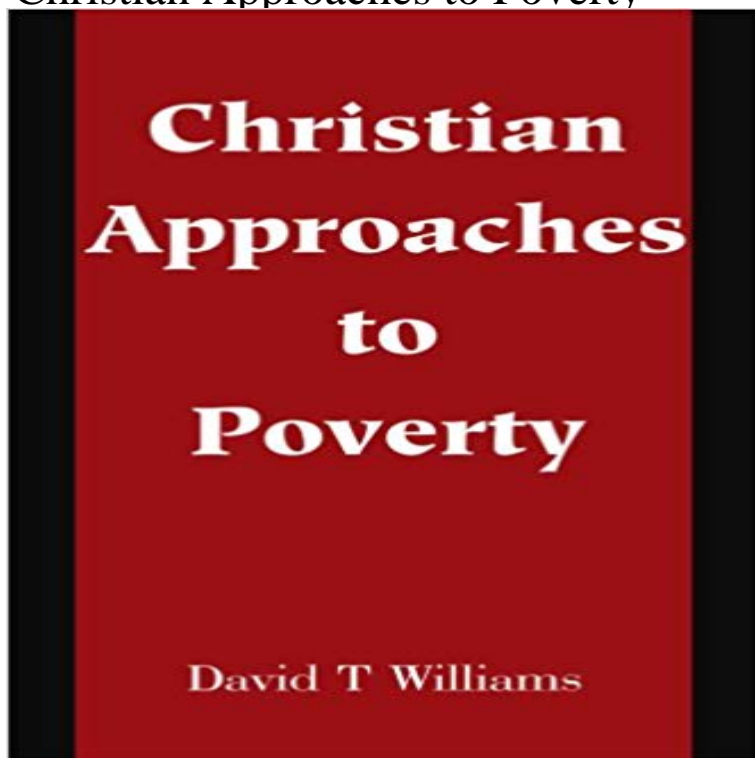


Christian Approaches to Poverty
