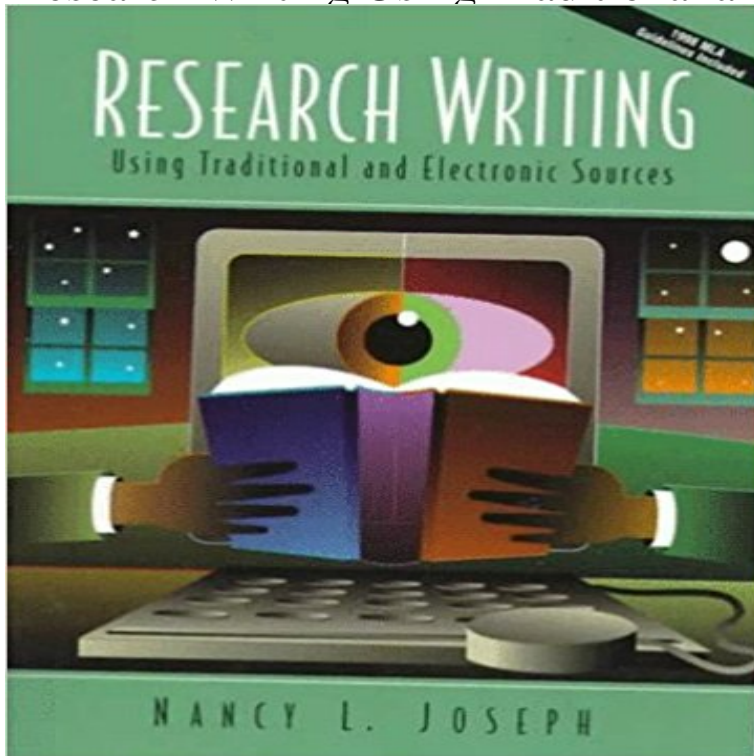


Research Writing Using Traditional and Electronic Sources
