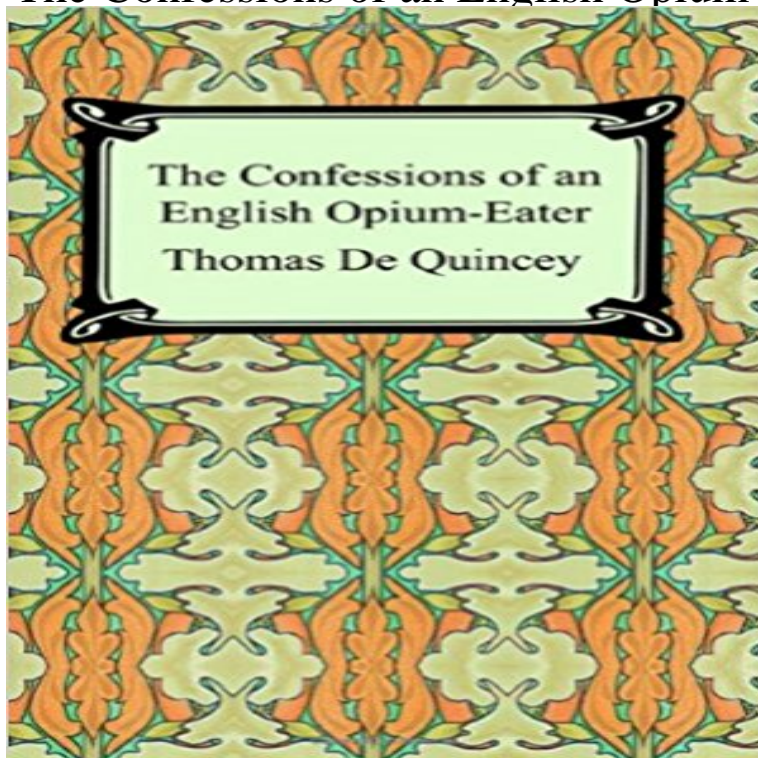


The Confessions of an English Opium-Eater
