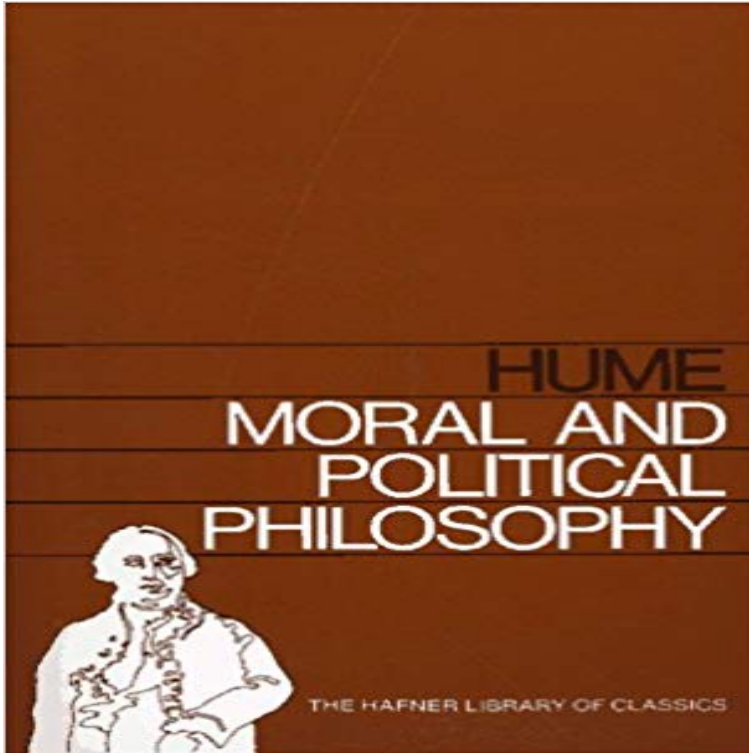


MORAL AND POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY
