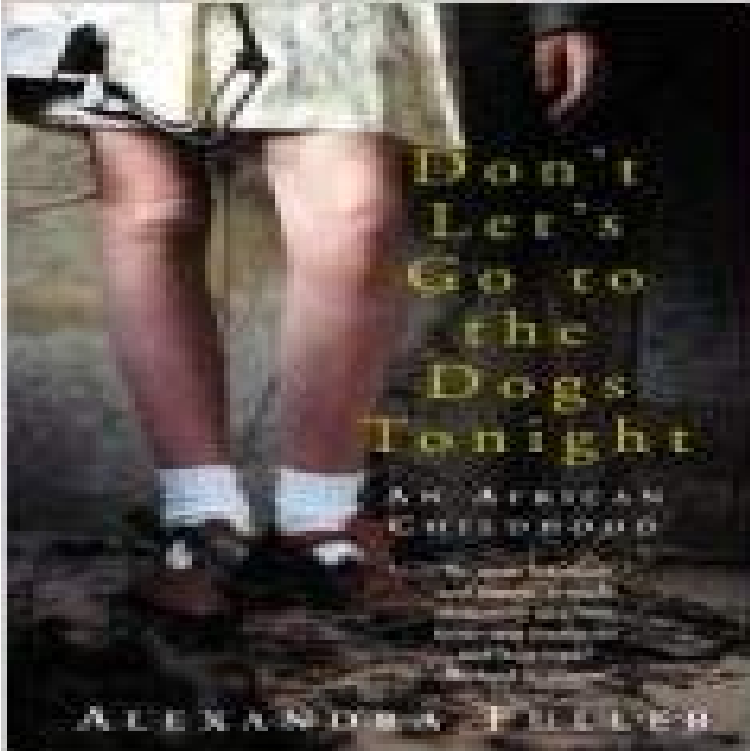


Dont Lets Go to the Dogs Tonight: An African Childhood
