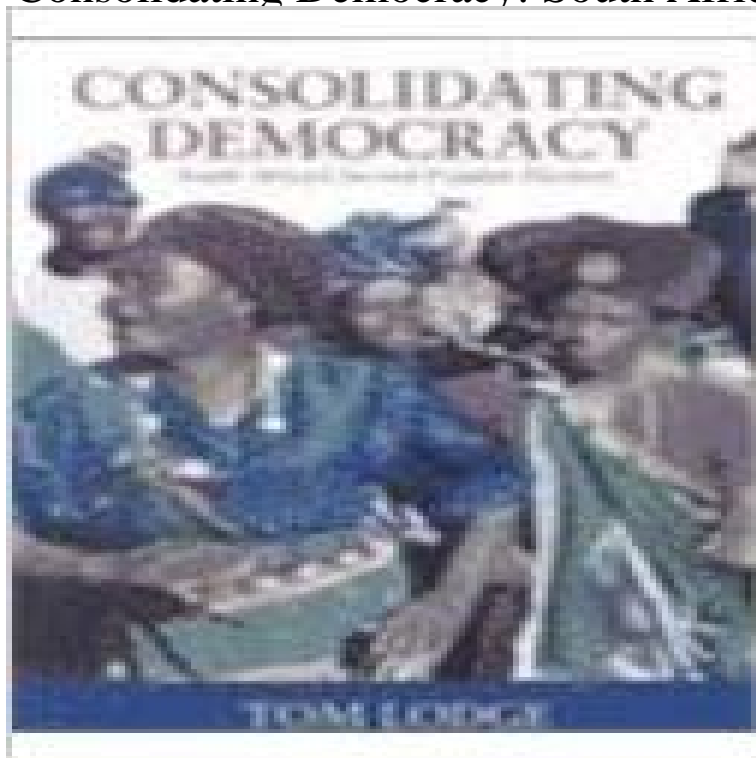


Consolidating Democracy: South Africa's Second Popular Election
