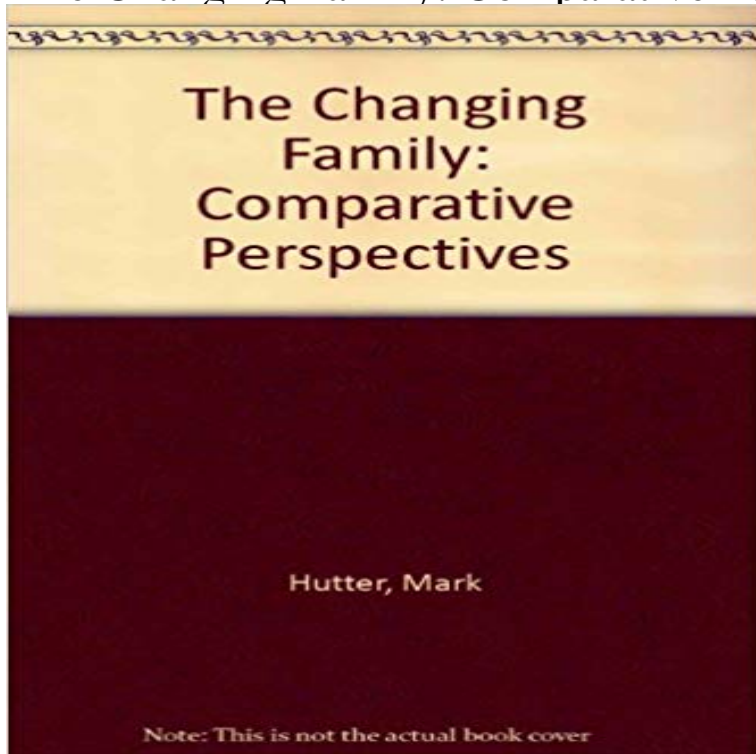


The Changing Family: Comparative Perspectives
