On the south shore of Samana Bay, which deeply indents this coast of the island, William M. Gabb explored some caves in 1869-1871 and found them to contain very extensive kitchen middens. Pottery and bones collected by him have been in the National Museum since 1872. A mong these bones were found, early in 191G, by Gerrit S. He obtained material of great interest and reported that large accumulations of shells, bones, and pottery remained to be examined. On these expeditions he made very interesting collections of mammals, birds, reptiles, mollusks, insects, and Indian artifacts.
