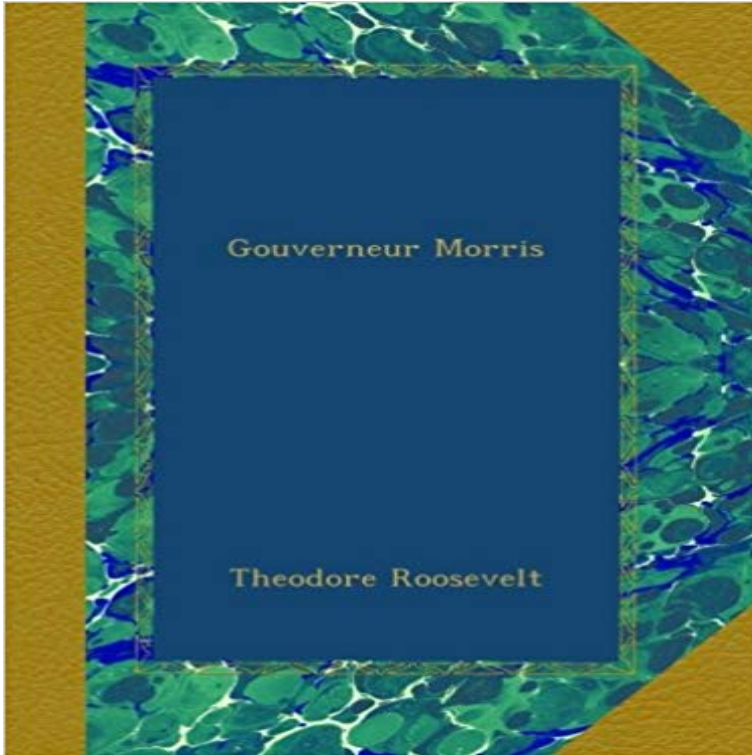


Gouverneur Morris
