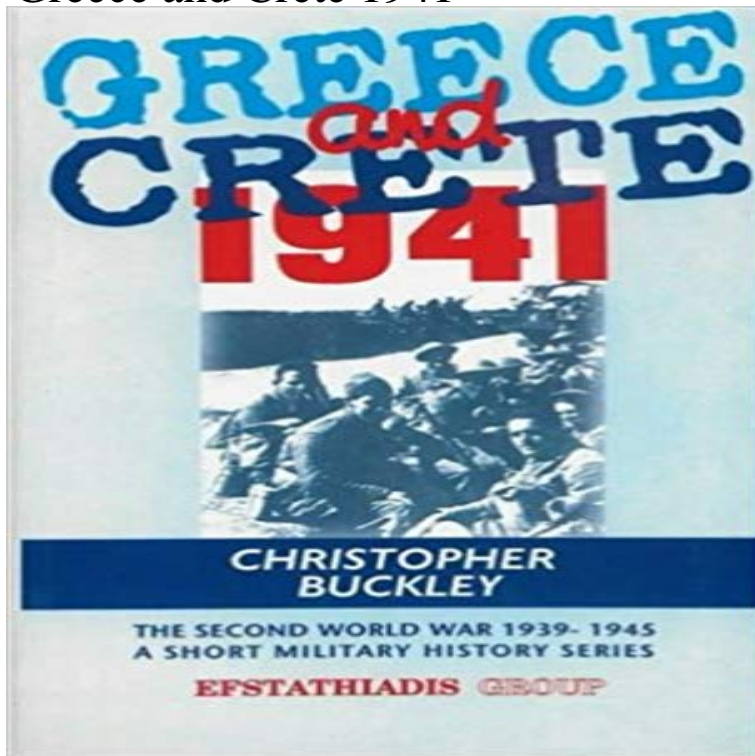


## Greece and Crete 1941
