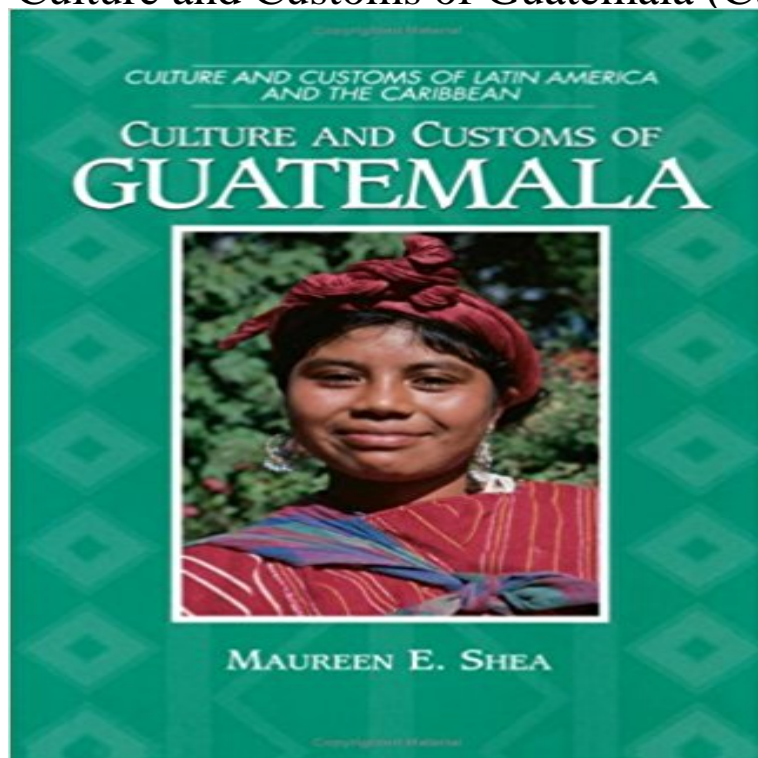


## Culture and Customs of Guatemala (Cultures and Customs of the World)
