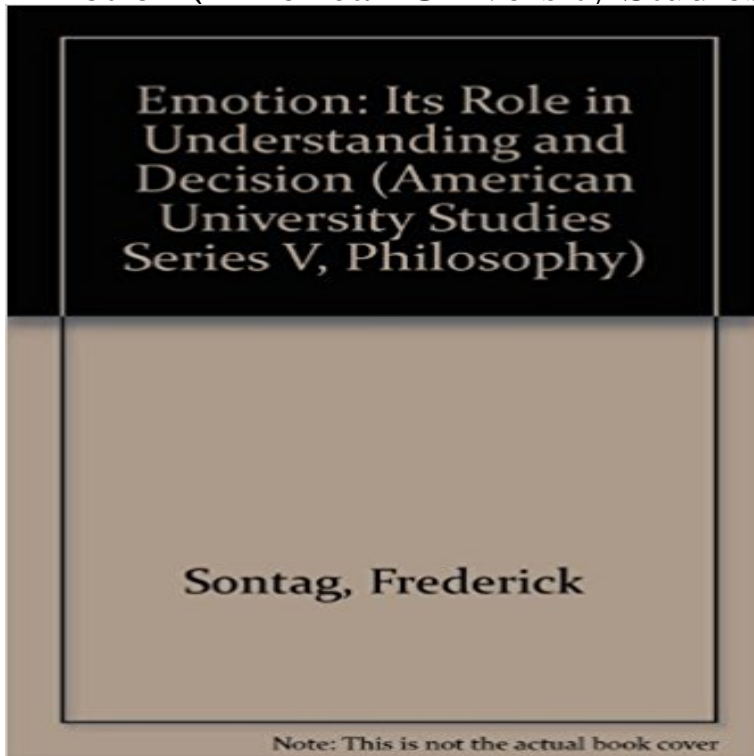


Emotion (American University Studies)
