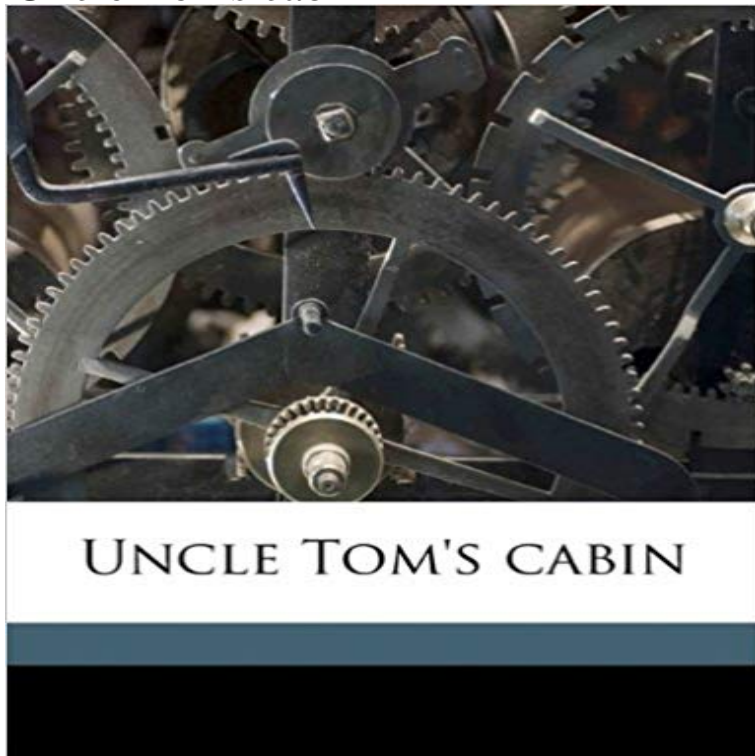


Uncle Toms cabin
