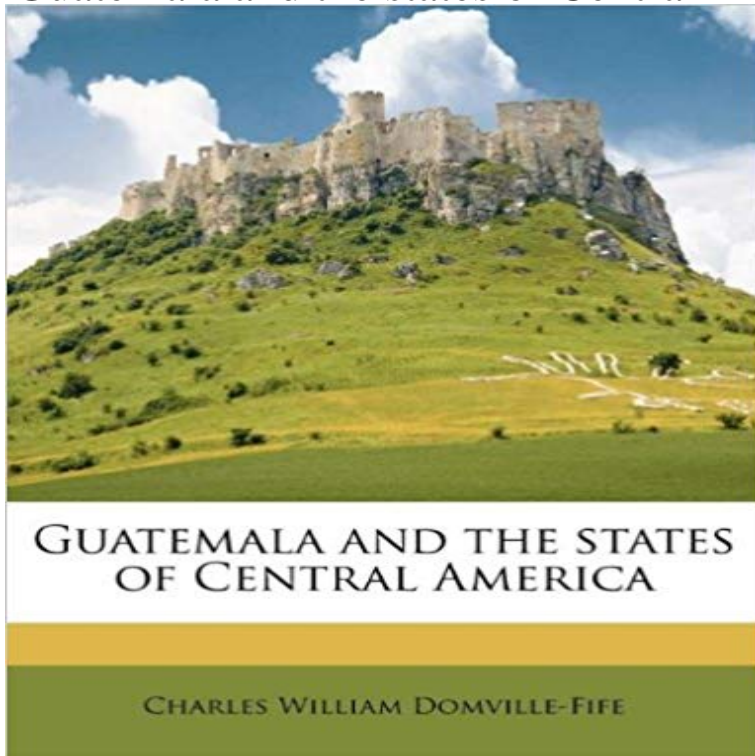


Guatemala and the states of Central America
