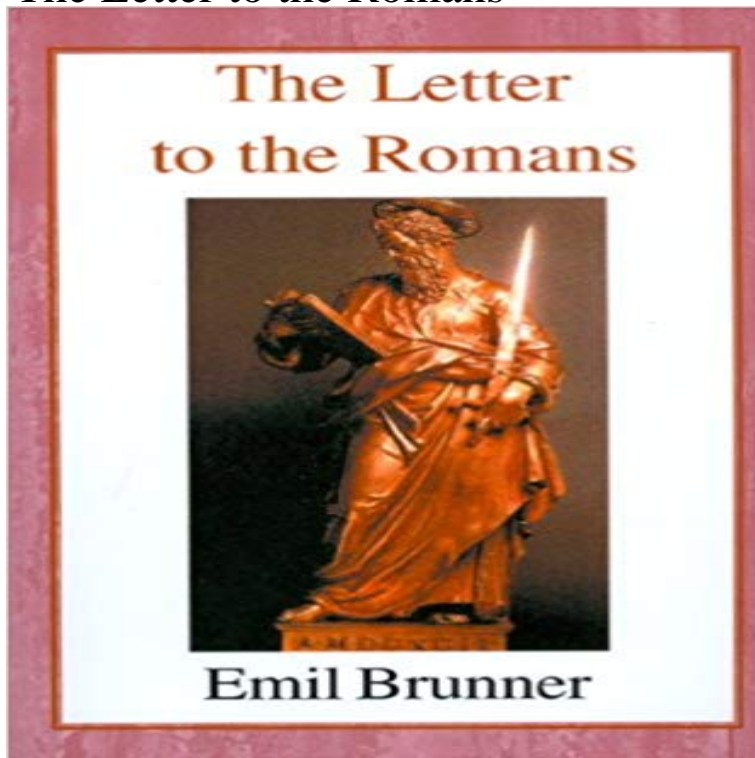


The Letter to the Romans
