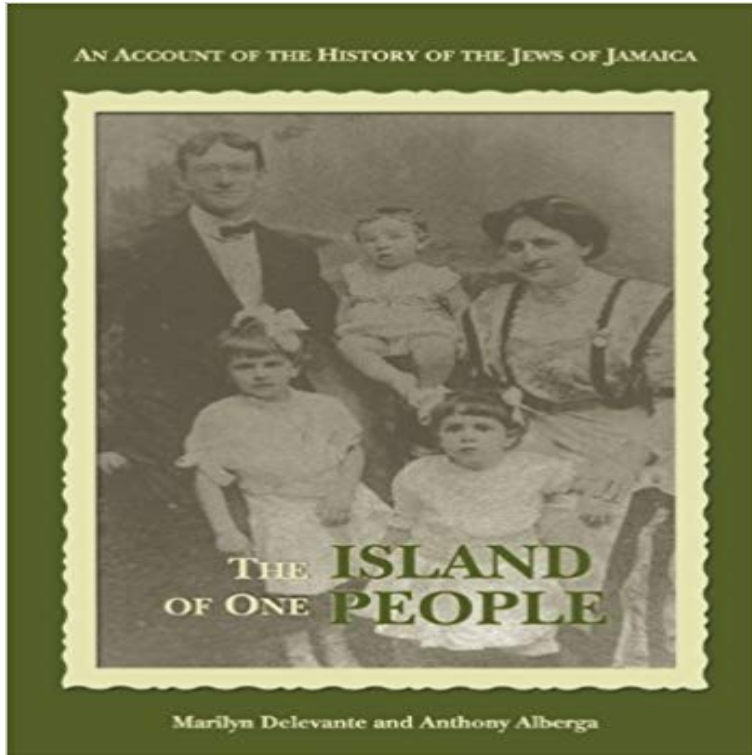


The Island of One People: An Account of the History of the Jews of Jamaica
