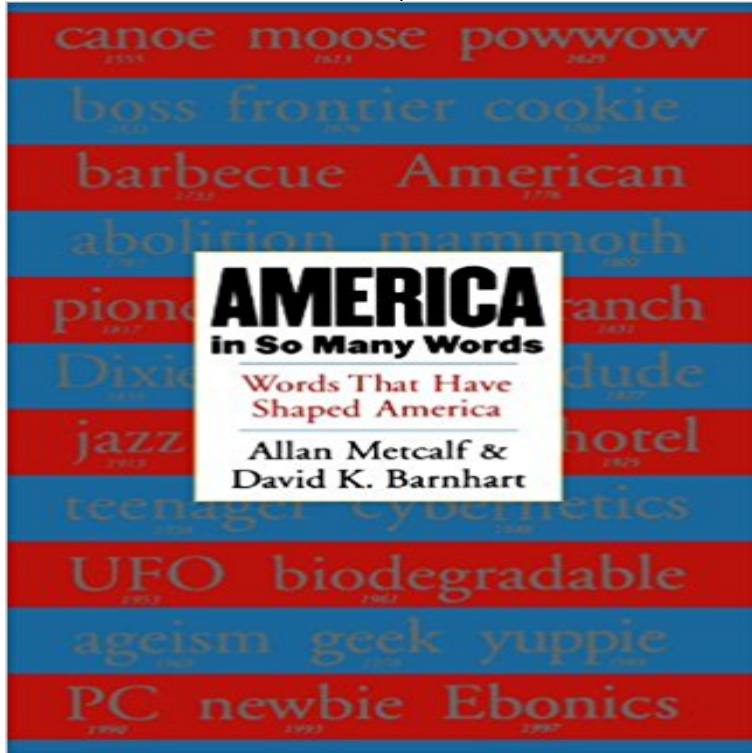


## America in So Many Words: Words That Have Shaped America
