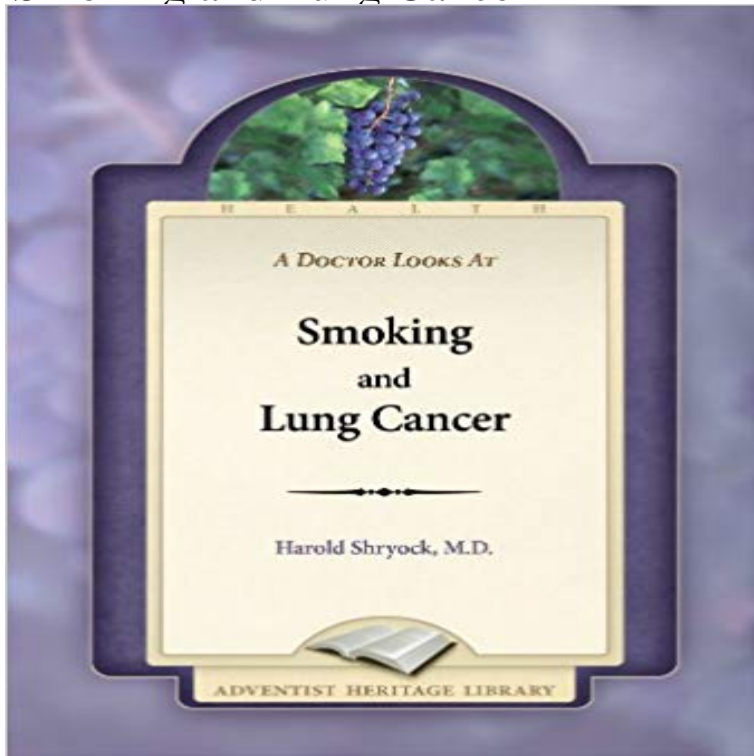


## Smoking and Lung Cancer
