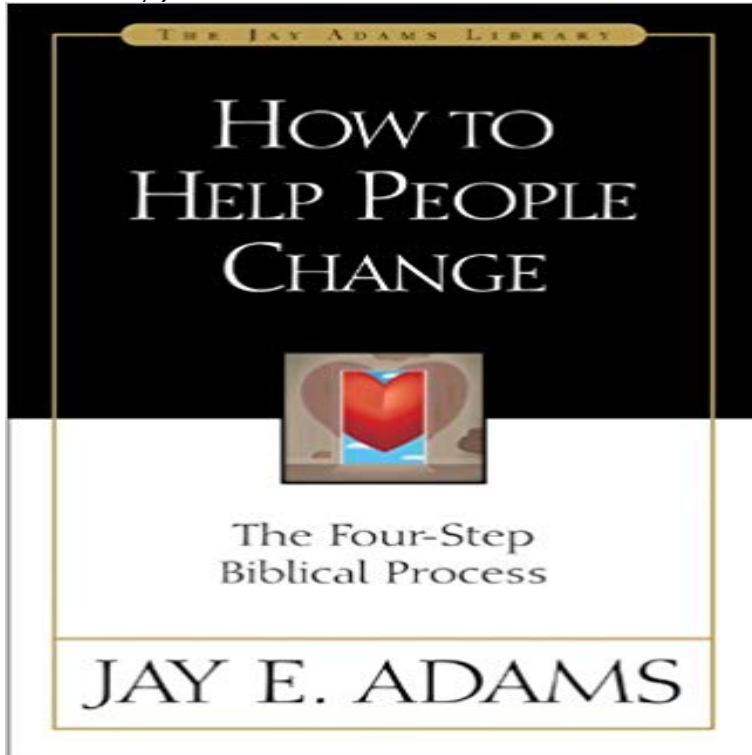


How to Help People Change: The Four-Step Biblical Process (Jay Adams Library)
