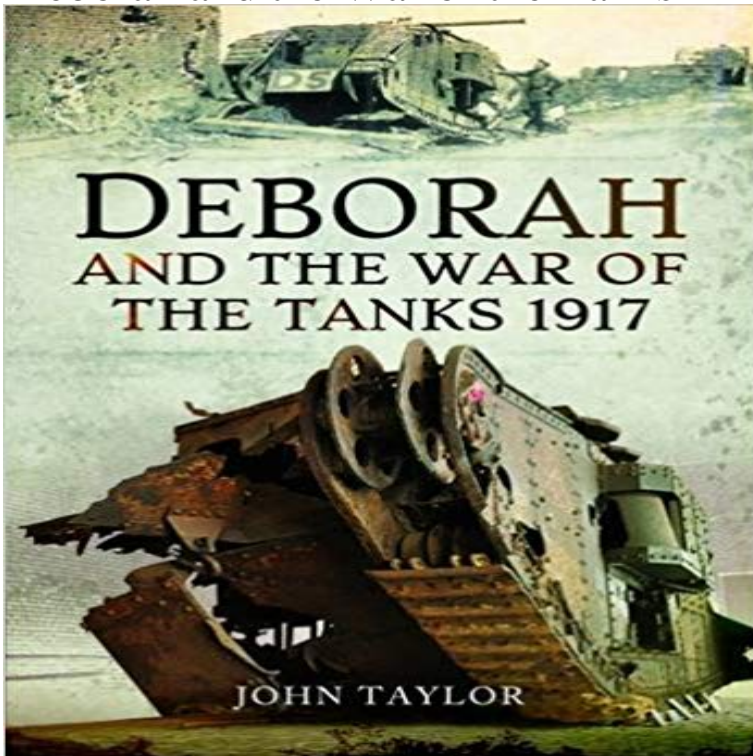


Deborah and the War of the Tanks
