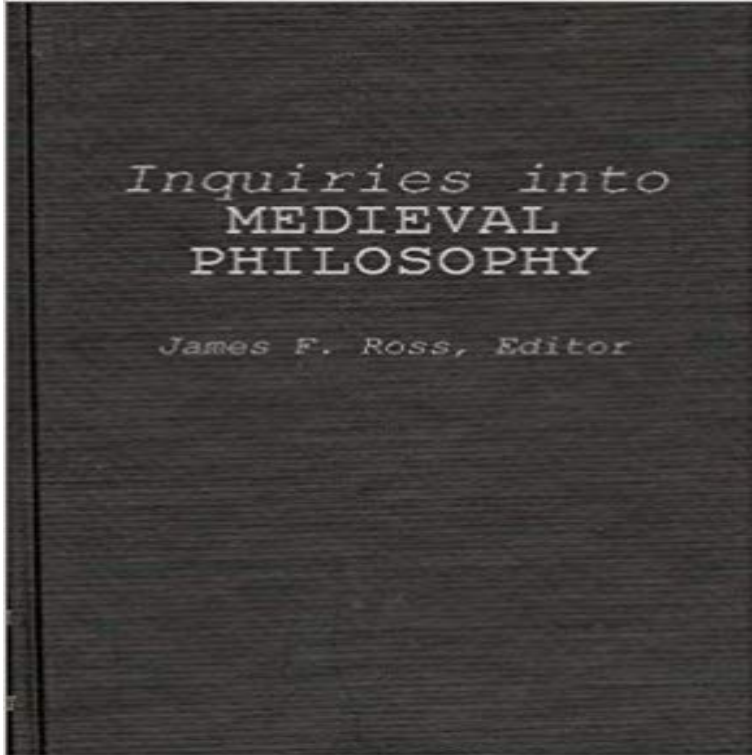


## Inquiries into Medieval Philosophy: A Collection in Honor of Francis P. Clarke (Contributions in Philosophy)
