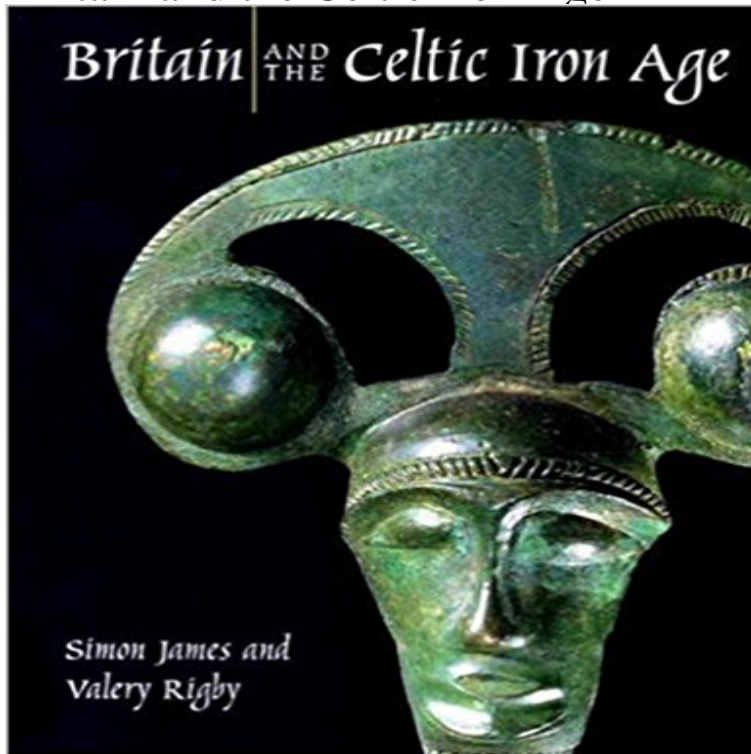


Britain and the Celtic Iron Age
