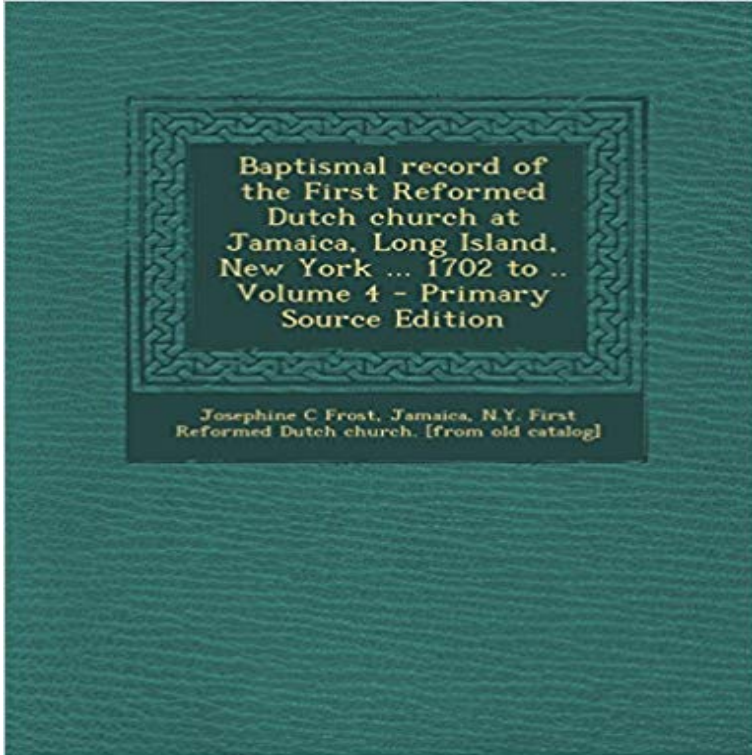


Baptismal Record of the First Reformed Dutch Church at Jamaica, Long Island, New York ... 1702 to .. Volume 4 - Primary Source Edition
