
THE GROUND-HOUSE INDIANS AND STONE-CIST GRAVE BUILDERS OF KANSAS AND NEBRASKA



[Note: this pre-1923 publication has been converted from original format and may contain an occasional defect from the conversion process or original source.] **KANSAS** NORTHEASTERN southeastern Nebraska were in- habited by Ground-house **Indians** long before Coronado, Onate and the Siouxan tribes of Indians set foot on Quiviran soil. Ground-house Indians were mound builders, buried their dead in different types of stone graves, and made three different types of pot- tery. It is not the purpose of the present paper to quote history, but to give a descriptive record of archaeological remains left by the people who in- habited Kansas before historic time and to record some Indian tradi-tions which may help to identify the people who left those remains.
