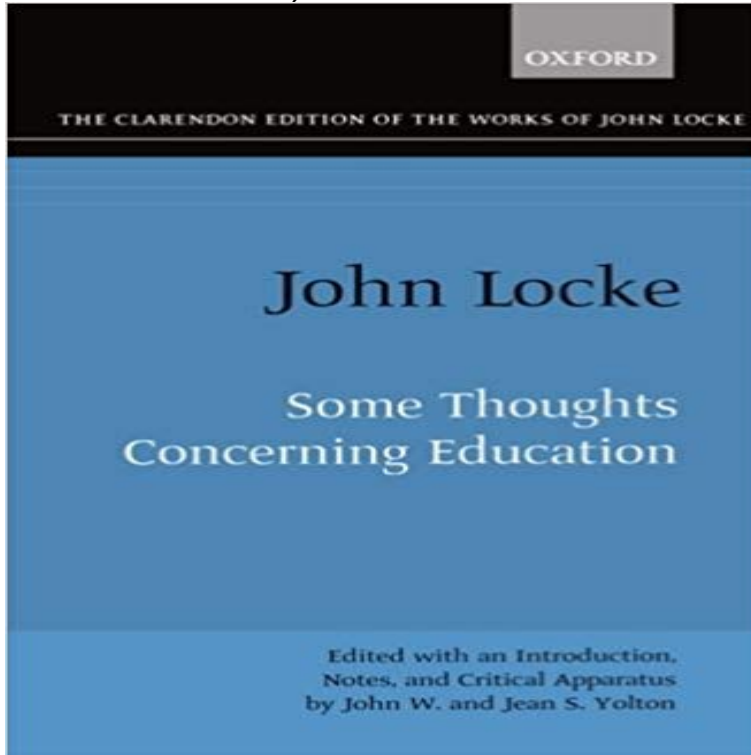


Some Thoughts Concerning Education (Clarendon Edition of the Works of John Locke)
