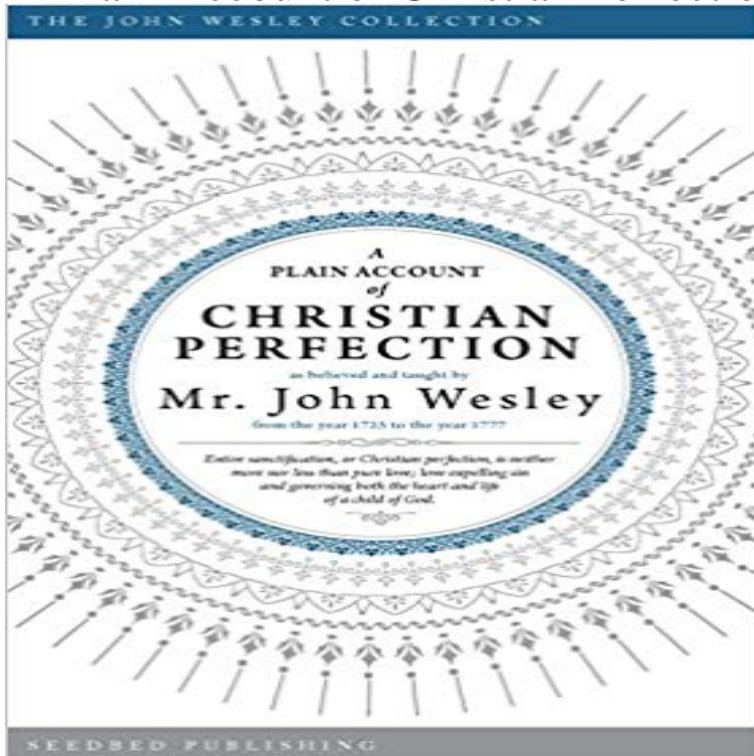


A Plain Account of Christian Perfection
