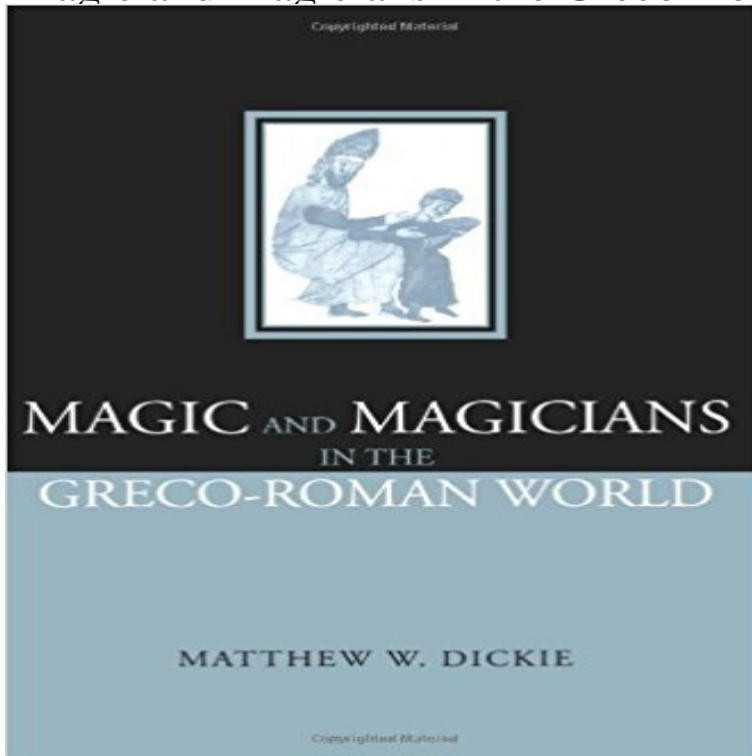


Magic and Magicians in the Greco-Roman World
