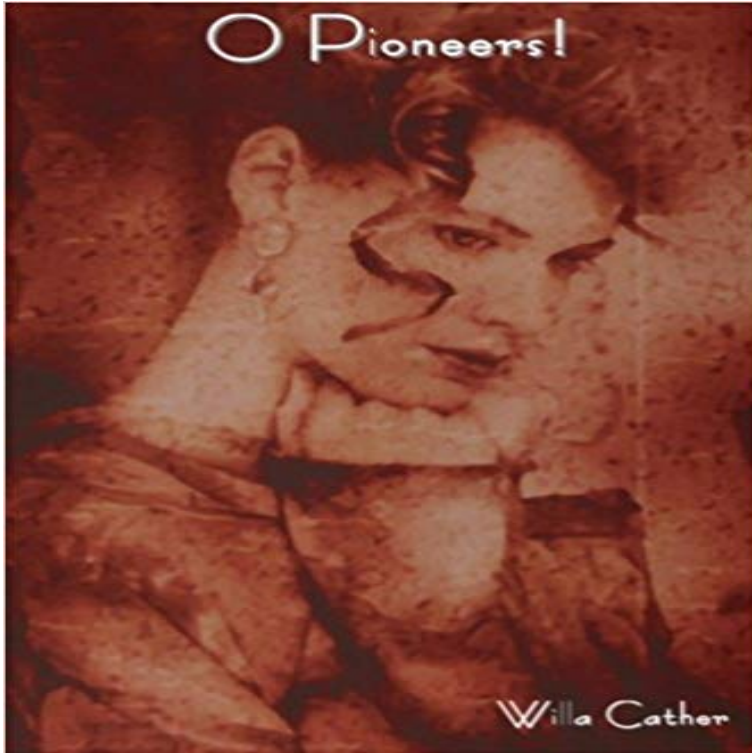


## O Pioneers!
