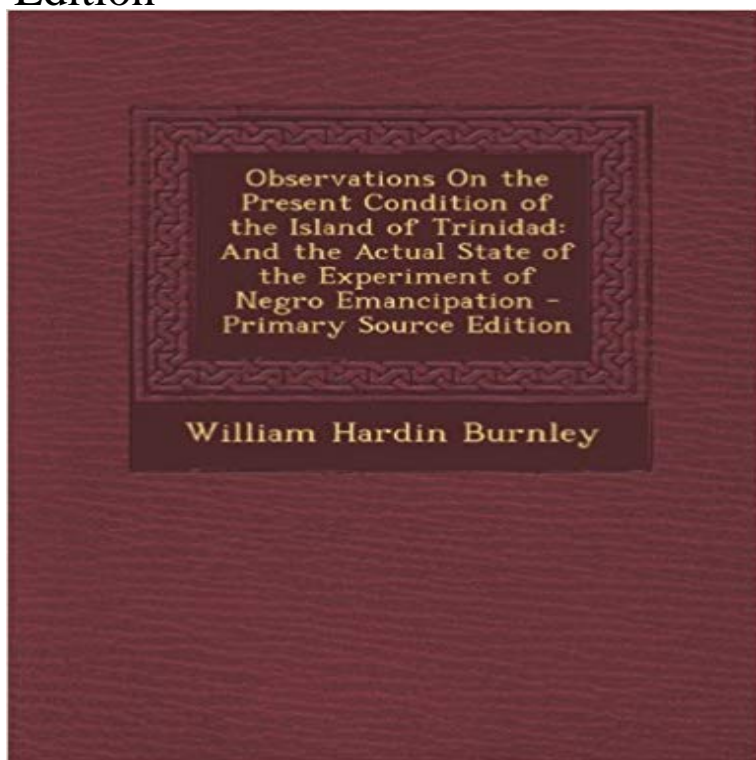


Observations on the Present Condition of the Island of Trinidad: And the Actual State of the Experiment of Negro Emancipation - Primary Source Edition
