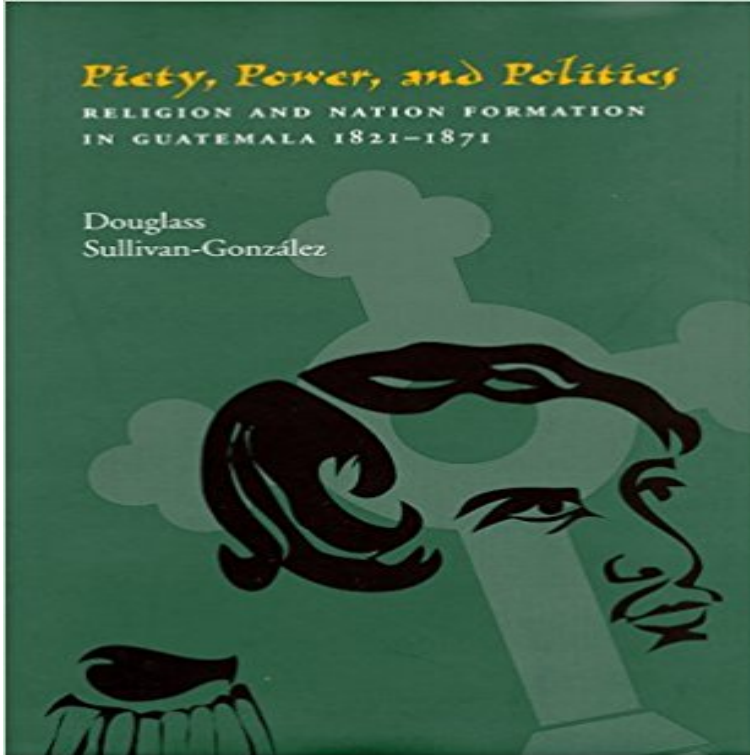


Piety, Power, and Politics: Religion and Nation Formation in Guatemala, 1821-1871 (Pitt Latin American Studies)
