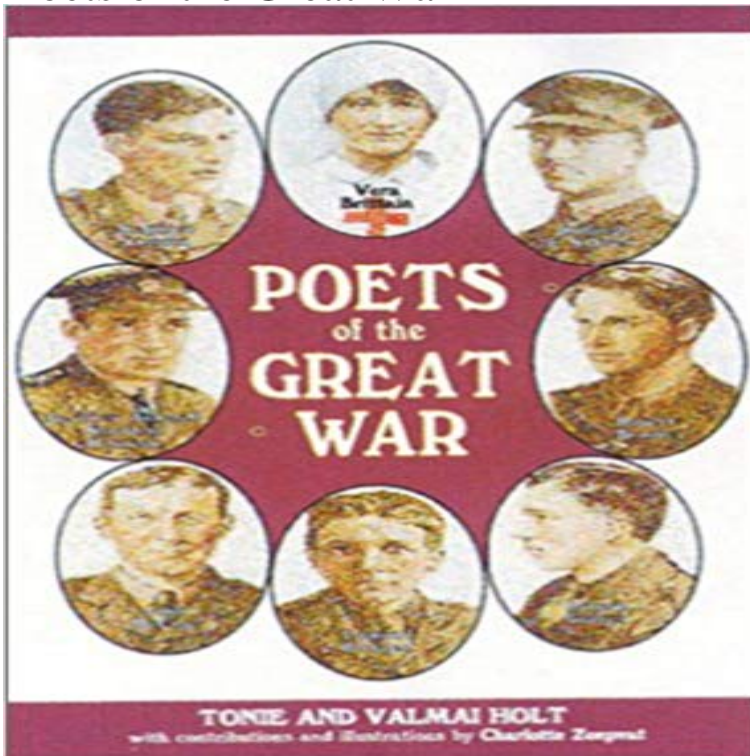


Poets of the Great War
