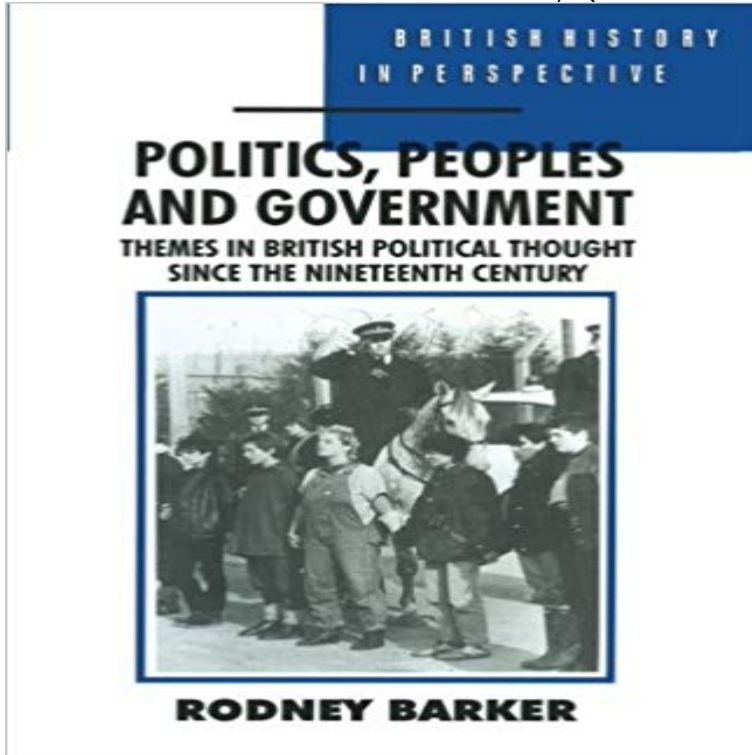


Politics, Peoples and Government: Themes in British Political Thought since the Nineteenth Century (British History in Perspective)
