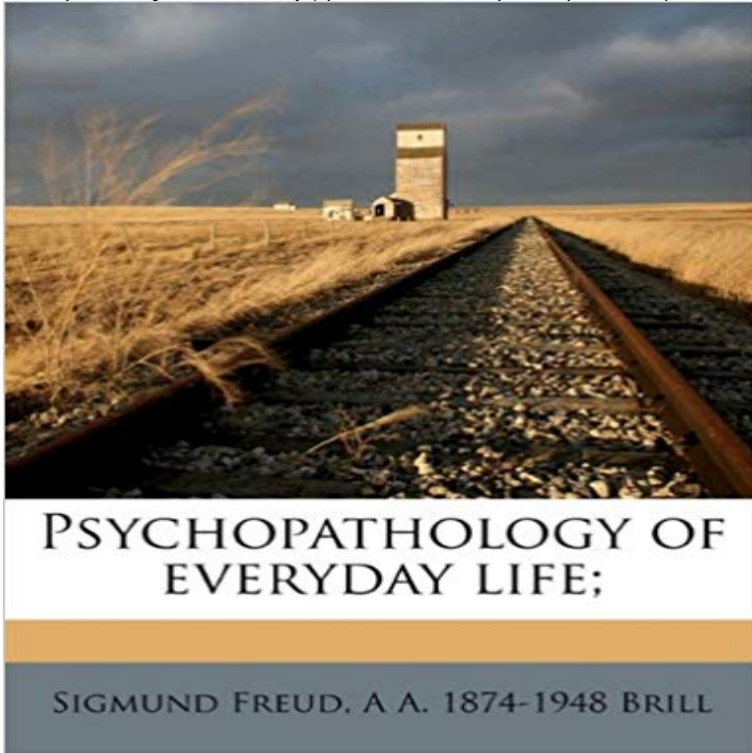


## Psychopathology of everyday life;
