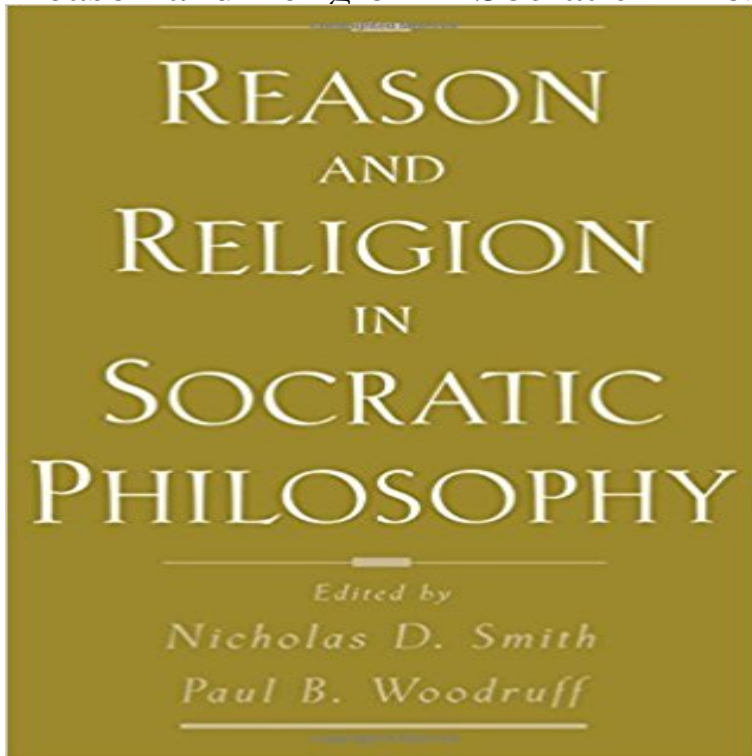


## Reason and Religion in Socratic Philosophy
